- Convey love and respect for the natural world
- Be willing to get dirty, handle animals, and engage deeply in nature
- Set up and break down tents and supplies each day
- · Have positive interactions with parents and staff
- Supervise and interact with children at all times
- Get to know your campers and provide a positive, supportive, and welcoming environment
- Review lesson plan and gather supplies prior to teaching the lesson
- Work as a team with your lead teacher and co-counselors
- Report and concerns to Camp Director in a timely manner
